Shopping

- 1000** – try on
- 2000** - queue
- 3000** – window (window counter)
- 4000** – shop assistant
- 5000** - manual
- 6000** – guarantee/warranty

Jobs

- 1000** – taxi driver, mechanic, architect, cabinet maker/carpenter, glass worker/glass cutter
- 2000** – secretary, nurse, teacher, waitress, hair dresser
- 3000** - salary
- 4000** – full time/part time job
- 5000** – flight attendant, nurse, chimneyer/chimney sweeper, cabinet maker/carpenter, roofer
- 6000** – A car mechanic works with cars. He works in a motor workshop. He repairs broken cars. He changes tires. He does a technical inspection. He works with various tools.

Health

- 1000** – to the hospital
- 2000** – head, arms, legs, back, abdomen
- 3000** – hand, elbow, arm, forearm, thumb, index finger, middle finger, ring finger, little finger
- 4000** – leg, knee, thigh, shin, foot
- 5000** – We have to wait in the waiting room. Then we go to the surgery. The doctor examines us. The nurse takes our blood. Then the doctor prescribes a medicine and writes a sick note.
